## A Personal Message...

Ever since we began our journey with the Heavenly Father, we have had a strong desire to share its joys with others. But how to explain the unexplainable? How to describe the amazing sense of God's presence in our lives and the wonderful feeling of being loved and special to God? How to explain the conviction that the Father has a perfect plan for each of us, even when things don't seem right to us at times? How to share our trust that God is always willing to forgive, and that He can lift us from any infirmity or misery if we only surrender to Him?

Without a personal experience of God, all human words are empty. Only He can speak directly to our hearts and convince us of His great love.

Imagine for a while a quiet, peaceful and safe place where you could sit down with the Heavenly Father and where you could ask and tell Him everything that is on your heart. A place where you would know for sure that He listens to you and that He is there just for you. The album "God of Mercy" is meant to create such a special place for you and the Father to meet. It is an invitation for you to open your heart to His love and to realize how precious you are in His eyes. It is an invitation for a journey with the Father during which you can experience His tender love and mercy.

One important way God manifests His love is by delivering us from our infirmities and by healing our wounds (Ps 30:2; Ps 103:2,5). Whether we realize it or not, we all carry wounds, be it spiritual, emotional or physical. They not only make our lives miserable but also hinder our faith and trust in God. This is definitely not what God wants for us. Rather, He loved us so much that He gave His only Son to redeem us from sin and to heal our infirmities (Isa 53:5,11). Moreover, the Father predestined us to become His children, and in His Son, Jesus, endowed us with a new dignity of the royal heirs, who share in the freedom, joy, and the happiness of the life of the Holy Trinity (Rom 8:17; Eph 1:4-6). This is our true identity and our destiny!

The album "God of Mercy" guides us through several steps on the journey to discovering the Father's loving heart and His wondrous plan for our lives. Each step takes us closer in our relationship with God. It is important to understand these steps before we set off on this journey:

- **Surrender** (music tracks 1-3) - This is where the journey really begins. It starts with a decision to open our hearts to God, to trust Him and to allow Him to take lordship and the central place in our lives.

- **Repentance, renunciation of sin and binding to God** (tracks 4-7) - The second important step on our journey is a personal conversion; this is when we resolve to turn away from sin, when we repent our sins, ask God for His forgiveness, renounce the evil and sin, and renew our commitment to God.

- **Healing** (tracks 8-9) - Now, that we are in the arms of the loving Father, we can tell Him everything that still hurts us, and ask Him to heal us - to heal our wounds, broken emotions, memories, attachment to sin and anything that may still separate us from Him. The purpose of this step is to remove any further obstacles that hinder our friendship with God. It is to experience freedom from spiritual bondage, so we can live with more joy in God's love.

- **New Pentecost** (tracks 10-13) - In this step we ask the Heavenly Father to send us His Holy Spirit to fill every void in our lives with His light, love, and peace. The Holy Spirit is the One who reveals to us the glorious plan and the purpose that the Father has for each one of us. With the Holy Spirit, we discover our true identity and the royal inheritance we have in the Father, through His Son, Jesus (Gal 4:4-6; 1 Pet 2:9).

- **Father's Blessing** (tracks 14-15) - The role of a father is to love, protect, provide, and to establish his children's identity. God, as a Perfect Father, wants to empower us with His blessing, so we can prosper and live a new life in Him, in true freedom, dignity, and fulfillment. The Father's blessing is the culminating point of our journey, since this is when the Father Himself assures us of His unfailing love and affirms our identity, purpose, and destiny. This is when He speaks to us: "My beloved son, my precious daughter, with you I am well pleased..."

As you listen to the album, we encourage you to use this booklet as a step-by-step commentary accompanying every music track. The commentary provides an additional explanation of each step that we are about to take.

Now, it is the time to enter our journey home with the Heavenly Father. We are praying that God reveals Himself to you so that, more than ever before, you may experience His love and the amazing blessings He has prepared for you.

## 1. God of Mercy

God of Mercy we worship You,  
God of Mercy we adore You.

## 2. Prayer of Surrender

*Commentary: Jesus, God's beloved Son, came to earth to reveal the Father to us (John 17:25-26; John 1:18). He said about Himself: "I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through Me." (John 14:6)*

*Today, Jesus is knocking on the door of our hearts and asks if we want to invite Him in. He comes to reconcile us to the Father. He loves us and wants to make us whole. With a child-like heart, let us surrender to Him everything we are. Let us allow Him to take us by the hand and walk us to our beloved Father...*

God, my Father, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit, I worship and glorify You. You are worthy to receive glory, and honor, and power. Your mercy has no limits. You are so good to me. I thank You for all Your blessings and gifts. I thank You for Your love and grace that transforms me and draws me closer to You.

You said: "Here I stand, knocking at the door. If anyone hears Me calling and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he will eat with Me." (Rev 3:20) I say to You today: Please come Lord Jesus! I open the door of my heart and want to commit my life to You!

Dear Lord Jesus, it is my will to surrender to You today, everything that I am, and everything that I am striving to be. I open the deepest areas of my heart to You, and invite Your Holy Spirit to dwell inside of me. I offer You my life, my heart, my mind, my body, soul, and spirit, with all my hopes, plans and dreams. I surrender to You my past, my present, and my future. I give You my health, my disabilities, physical appearance, home, family, marriage, children, and friendships. Jesus, I ask You to take Lordship over every aspect of my life. I surrender to You my broken heart, with all my hurt, pain, worry, anxiety, and fear, and I ask You to wash me clean. I release everything into Your loving and compassionate care.

Lord, please speak to my heart. Open my ears to hear Your voice. Help me to confide in You more deeply. I desperately need to feel Your loving embrace. Please Lord, shut the doors that need to be shut, and open the doors that need to be opened. Set my feet upon the straight and narrow road that leads to everlasting life. I ask in Your name. Amen.

### 3. I Surrender to You

I'm sitting here in silence,

I surrender completely to You!  
I surrender...

Lord, I surrender to You,

Commit my ways to You and trust in You.  
Take all of my misery and wretchedness,  
Prepare my heart for Yourself!  
I surrender...

I surrender, I give You my yes, I give You my yes!  
Carry me away to the depth of Your love that never ends!  
I surrender, I give You my yes, I give You my yes! I surrender!

I surrender, Lord Jesus, I snuggle to Your merciful heart!  
Transform me the way You wish, my heart is Yours, let there be light!  
I surrender...

### 4. Jesus, Forgive Me

*Commentary: God is the Father, and out of His great love He created us and predestined us to be His beloved children. But, in the Garden of Eden, the human race rejected God and thus separated itself from God and His blessing. And yet, even though we weren't faithful to Him, the Father never gave up on us. Therefore, He sent His Son to reconcile us to Himself. Jesus paid a terrible price for our redemption: He was beaten, scourged, crucified, and died a terrifying death on the cross. But by His death He redeemed us from the power of Satan and liberated us from the slavery of sin. By His resurrection, Jesus opened for us the way to a new life in freedom. Let us now humble our hearts and ask for His forgiveness. Let us repent and be sorry for everything we have done that offended and hurt His wounded heart.*

"He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities. The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way, but the Lord has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him." (Isa 53:5-6)

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life..." and He tells you today: "Though your sins are like scarlet, I will make them as white as snow. Though they are red like crimson, I will make them as white as wool." (John 3:16; Isa 1:18)

"If we say, 'we are without sin', we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we acknowledge our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from every wrongdoing." (1 John 1:8-9)

Jesus, please forgive me. I'm so sorry when I think about how much You had to suffer for me... It was not the weight of the cross, but the weight of my sins which made You suffer so much. Have mercy on me, I am heartily sorry for having offended and hurt You - You who love me so much... Jesus, please open my eyes and show me my sin. Help me change my ways.

Please show me everything what separates me from You and from the fullness of Your blessing.

## 5. In Your Name I Forgive...

*Commentary: We have just asked the Father to forgive us our sins. Yet, if we want to receive the fullness of His forgiveness, we also need to forgive others (Mk 11:23-25). Unforgiveness separates us from God's grace and affects us physically, mentally, and spiritually. Holding unforgiveness is like carrying a heavy burden that binds us to the past and to a person who has hurt us.*

*Jesus wants us to be free from these negative consequences of unforgiveness. Sometimes, though, forgiveness seems beyond our human capability. This is when Jesus comes to us with His power and helps us forgive. Forgiveness is not a feeling - it's a decision of the will. When we pronounce forgiveness, the power behind unforgiveness is defeated, and we may walk in freedom again.*

Jesus told His disciples, "Have faith in God! I tell all of you with certainty, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' if he doesn't doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him.

That is why I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. Whenever you stand up to pray, forgive whatever you have against anyone, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins." (Mk 11:23-25)

Heavenly Father, teach me Your ways, that I may walk in Your truth. Please reveal to me all the people that I need to forgive and help me forgive them.

I lift up to You, all the difficult people and situations in my life. In Jesus' name, I choose to forgive them for upsetting me, for rejecting me and for hurting me. I forgive them for making me feel so alone, so unloved, so guilty, for causing me so much pain, and for demanding too much from me. In Jesus' name I forgive them for making me feel afraid, worthless, and bitter.

I also ask you, Father, to forgive them for doing these things to me.

I ask that you forgive me, for holding a judgement against each one of them, for holding in my heart anger, resentment, and bitterness towards these people. I know that this is sinful and I choose to repent.

Father, I ask You to forgive me, that at times I have blamed You, for things that went wrong in my life, things that were not Your fault. I know that You have loved me with a steadfast love, that You were always with me, even when I didn't feel Your presence, and that You hate what Satan has done in my life. I'm sorry that I didn't trust You and didn't believe that You cared for me.

Jesus, please reveal to me all the people who hurt me and help me forgive them.  
Jesus, in Your name, I forgive...

*At this moment let us ask Jesus to reveal to us all the people who have hurt us, and let us ask Him to help us forgive them. Whenever a name or an image of any such person appears in our minds, let us repeat the words: "Jesus, in Your name I forgive...(the name of a person) for doing... or for saying ... ". Let us next pause for a second until Jesus shows us another person to continue our prayer of forgiveness, and then repeat the same prayer.*

*We may need more time than the duration of this music track to go through all negative situations and people in our lives to forgive. It is recommended to continue the prayer and even to repeat this prayer in the future, whenever we find in our hearts a need to forgive someone.*

*The fruit of forgiveness is peace and freedom. The forgiveness we extend through Jesus to someone will not only help us, but can also transform their hearts.*

## 6. I Choose You. Deliver Me, Lord

*Commentary: Jesus defeated Satan and death on the cross, and He offered us a new life in Him. His Kingdom - The Kingdom of Heaven - is at hand, but we need to decide for ourselves that we want to choose it over the kingdom of darkness (Deut 30:15-20).*

*In this step, we are going to renounce Satan and sin, and renew our commitment to God. By renouncing Satan, his lies and all his works, we declare that we no longer make a home for sin or the deceptions and power behind it, and we no longer agree with the lies that have been buried in our hearts and in our thoughts. By submitting to God and by renewing our baptismal promises, we open our hearts to God's all-transforming love. When we choose to belong to Jesus, Satan and sin no longer have a dominion over us (Rom 6:9-14).*

"So this I say, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind, being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their hearts. But you did not learn Christ in this way, if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth." (Eph 4:17-18, 20-24)

"Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous. He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God." (1 John 3:7-9)

My God, I believe in You and I choose You. I want to commit my life to You and to renew my baptismal vows now: I believe in You, God, my Father almighty, You, who loved me even before You created heaven and earth. I believe in You, Jesus Christ, God the Father's only Son, my Lord and Savior. You, who were born of the Virgin Mary, were crucified, died and were buried, rose again from the dead, and are seated at the right hand of the Father. I believe in You, Holy Spirit, Lord and Giver of Life, my Helper and Advocate sent by the Father.

In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ I renounce Satan and all of his works in my life, in all its forms, whether brought into my life by my actions or by others. I renounce sin and everything what leads me to it. I break all attachments, curses, spells, malefic, evil eye, and rights Satan may have in my life whether such ground was gained through my actions or through others. Powerful in the holy authority of the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, I command Satan and all his minions, whomever they may be, to get out of my life and stay out.

With that authority I now take back the ground in my life gained by Satan through my sins. I reclaim this ground and my life for Christ. I now dedicate myself to the Lord Jesus Christ. I belong to Him alone.

Heavenly Father, wash me clean in the Blood of Your Son, Jesus, and give to me a right spirit. A spirit that will worship You, glorify You, and serve You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

## 7. I Bind Myself to You

*Commentary: Let us bind our hearts to God and entrust everything that we are and we have to Him. He is our Father who loves us beyond our understanding. He knows what we need and what is best for us.*

Heavenly Father, Almighty God,  
In the name of Your Son, Jesus Christ,  
I bind myself to You, in every way I do,  
I bind my heart to Your Heart.

I bind my will to Your will,  
I give You all my desires and dreams.  
You know what is best for me,  
You have a purpose for my life and it's perfect!

I bind my future to Your Love,  
There's nothing You can't do, You're giving me more!  
My family's needs, health and home,  
It's Yours as I unite myself with You!

I bind my mind to Your Mind,  
My body, spirit, soul, I bind to Jesus' blood.  
May Your word renew and set me free,  
So I belong completely to You, my King!

## 8. Prayer for Healing

*Commentary: God the Father has restored His Kingdom on earth through His Son. During His earthly ministry Jesus proclaimed: "The Kingdom of God is at hand - the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised" (Mk 1:15). Jesus' heart is full of love and compassion on our infirmities. He said: "Truly, truly, I say to you, if you ask anything of the Father, He will give it to you in My name" (John 16:23). Let's pray with a child-like faith and ask the Father to touch us with the healing power of His Love.*

"I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." (Lk 11: 9-10)

God, the Father, I now surrender my whole being to You: my spiritual, emotional and physical health. I belong to You and entrust myself to You. I believe You can heal me and I ask You to touch me with Your healing power in Your son Jesus' name. I believe, but please increase in me faith, hope and love, so I can surrender to You like a baby in its mother's arms.

Lord Jesus, You know me much better than I know myself. I invite You to enter my heart and touch all those life experiences which need to be healed. Please come to the very moment when I was conceived in my mother's womb and cleanse me with Your precious blood and wipe away all negative experiences. All through the nine months in my mother's womb, whatever negative experiences have come to me from my mother and now remains in my unconscious mind, wash it away in Your precious blood and heal me. Come into my life and heal me of the psychological harms that struck me in my early years and from the injuries that they have caused throughout my life.

Father, heal my wounded heart. Heal the pain of my memories, so that nothing that has happened to me will cause me to remain in pain and anguish, filled with anxiety. Heal, O Lord, all those wounds that have been the cause of all the evil that is rooted in my life. Heal me from my addictions and sinful behavioral patterns.

I want to forgive all those who have offended me. Please look to those inner wounds that make me unable to forgive. You who came to forgive the afflicted of heart, please, heal my own heart.

Heal me, Father, from the pain caused by the death of my loved ones, which is oppressing me. Fill me with Your love, peace and joy. Touch me, heal me and make me whole. I am your child. I belong to You and I depend on You.

Heavenly Father, heal those wounds that cause me physical illness. By the power and authority that You gave me, in the name of Your Son, Jesus Christ, I renounce and break the power of every spirit of sickness, disease and infirmity that would attempt to establish itself in my body, soul, mind and spirit, and I command it to leave me now and go straight to the foot of the cross for Jesus Christ to do with as He will. Amen.

## 10. New Pentecost

*Commentary: The Holy Spirit is a promised gift from God the Father. Jesus Himself asked the Father to give us a helper who would be with us forever, would teach us all things, and testify of Truth (John 14:16,26). The Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness - "If we don't know how to pray as we should, the Holy Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words" (Rom 8:26). The Holy Spirit is also the pledge of our heavenly inheritance (Eph1:14) - it is God's Spirit dwelling in us and transforming us so we can become more like Jesus and in Him enjoy more fully the life of beloved sons and daughters of the Most High.*

"When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance." (Acts 2:1-4)

Lord Jesus, when Peter filled with Your Holy Spirit started to preach about You, saying that You are the true Messiah, that You died and resurrected, they were all amazed and pierced to the heart. They asked Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what should we do?", and he answered to them, "Every one of you must repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus the Messiah for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the Holy Spirit as a gift. For this promise belongs to you and your children, as well as to all those who are distant, whom the Lord our God may call to Himself." (Acts 2:37-39)

## 11. Come Holy Spirit

*Commentary: Let us invite the Holy Spirit to our hearts now and ask Him to touch us with His love and to renew our lives.*

Lord Jesus, You said about Your Father that He'd send the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him, so I ask You, now, my Father in Heaven, please send Your Holy Spirit! Pour down the rain of Your power and love. Breath on me to receive the Spirit. Touch me, transform me and renew me! Purify me by baptizing me in the Holy Spirit and stir into flame Your gifts!

I am your child, Your beloved child. Father, please, send me Your Spirit! Come Holy Spirit!

## 12. Heavenly Inheritance

*Commentary: Through Christ we have all become God's sons and daughters. Yet, because of the devil's lies, we may still have lived our lives like orphans - in place of feeling loved, forgiven and totally accepted, we may have felt unworthy, guilty or abandoned; in place of being led by faith and trust in the Father, we have been driven by fears and anxieties; instead of running towards our Father, we have been escaping from Him.*

*It is time to change that state and to claim our heavenly inheritance (Gal 5:1). Now that we have broken and rejected Satan's lies in our lives, there is nothing that should stop us from fully embracing our true nature of God's beloved children and heirs (Rom 8:35-39).*

"Brothers and sisters, behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure." (1John 3:1-3)

"Those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a spirit of adoption, through which we cry, "Abba, Father!" The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if only we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him." (Rom 8:14-17)

God the Father, help me to appreciate the dignity that You give me in Your Son, Jesus Christ. Holy Spirit, reveal the truth to me, help me discover the amazing grace of being Your child, Your heir.

## 13. We Are Your Heirs

We are the temple of the Holy Spirit,  
We are His holy ground.  
We are so loved by the King of Heaven,  
We are justified in Jesus' blood!

We are Your heirs, Your beloved children,  
A holy nation, Your special people.  
Before You made the world You loved and chose us,

#### 14. Message from the Father

*Commentary: Faith, repentance, forgiveness, and renunciation of the evil have prepared our hearts for this final step on our journey - the blessing from the Heavenly Father.*

*In the blessing God reveals to us that He is our Father. He loves us and affirms our identity, purpose, and destiny. He wants to give us peace, joy, and fulfillment in our lives. He wants to empower us to prosper and thrive in a new life that we have in His Son, Jesus Christ. Let us open our hearts to the message from God the Father, our Beloved "Abba" (Gal 4:6).*

My beloved child, I see all your ways. I know your thoughts, I know your words even before you say them. I am your Father. I loved you even before I formed you in your mother's womb. You are so precious to Me.

I'm filled with compassion when I see your wounds and suffering. I myself go out to search for you and I carry you back home on my shoulders. I forgive you of all your sins. Repent of them.

I not only forgive you but I restore you and bring you back to your dignity that you have in Me, through my Son Jesus. I put on you my finest robe as a sign of my love, complete approval and protection over you. I put a ring on your hand as a sign of your inheritance and authority that you have in the name of my Son, Jesus Christ. And I put sandals on your feet because you are no longer a slave to sin, you are my child, my heir - a joint heir with my Son, Jesus.

My hand is upon you, and I empower you today with my love and my blessing. I give you everything I have. I give you the gift of my precious Son, Jesus. I give you the power of my Spirit. Receive a new life in my Son, Jesus. Be free and dwell in your inheritance which is my kingdom in you. In Me you can do everything!

Thank You, Father, for Your blessing! Thank You, Father, for taking me by my hand and leading me home. Thank You for setting me free and for helping me to discover the dignity I have in You. I want to bless You and give You thanks! To You, my God and Father, be glory for ever and ever!

Bless God and give Him thanks before all the living,  
For the good things He's done for you bless His name.  
Proclaim before all the deeds of God, don't be slack in thanksgiving,

My soul exalts the King of Heaven, rejoice and sing,  
Rebuilt in me Your house, oh King, and dwell in me.  
You are my Lord, You are my God, my Father forever,  
I think of what You've done for me and give You thanks!

May He gladden all who are captives,  
May He cherish all distressed,  
Bless His name forever and ever,  
He's the King of Mercy! Amen!
